- CMU-IBM Cyberinfrastructure for MINLP. This is a collaborative site that is nearing completion, and has as a major objective to promote the optimization of nonlinear models involving discrete and continuous variables through mixed-integer nonlinear programming (MINLP). Two major challenges in this area are model formulation and solution algorithms. For model formulation, this site contains a collection of MINLP problems for which high level descriptions are provided together with one or several model formulations with their corresponding input files. Researchers and practitioners will be able to contribute to the library of problems and models, and to participate in the discussions on these problems. The site will also contain information on tutorials, bibliography and resources on MINLP. You will receive an email within the next month announcing the availability of this new website where we hope you will be able to contribute with your problems.

- Faculty News

- Larry Biegler served as an evaluator for the Special Priority Program on "PDE-Constrained Optimization" funded by the German National Science Foundation. In May, he will be a visiting professor at Zhejiang University in Hangzhou, China, where he will present short courses on nonlinear programming and dynamic optimization. In Fall, 2009, Larry will be the Hougen Visiting Professor at the University of Wisconsin, where he will interact with PSE colleagues, Christos Maravelias, Jim Rawlings and Ross Swaney.
- Ignacio Grossmann gave the seminars "Process Synthesis and Optimization" at Dow Chemical in Midland, and "On the Scope of Discrete-Continuous Optimization in Process Systems Engineering," at the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering, Lehigh University. He also gave two papers at the INFORMS Computing Society Meeting in Charleston on disjunctive programming and cyberinfrastructure for MINLP problems. Ignacio also participated in the advisory board meetings of the Chemical Engineering Departments of Penn State, Princeton and Purdue.
- Nick Sahinidis is continuing the work on editing a special issue on "Global Optimization" for the journal *Optimization Methods and Software*. Sixteen papers have been accepted and three more are under review. The volume is expected to be completed by early summer 2009. Nick organized a session on "Derivative-free Optimization" at the 2009 Computational Management Science conference in Geneva, where he also gave a presentation on a review and comparison of derivative-free algorithms.
- Erik Ydstie gave seminars on "Process Control and Complex Process Networks" at the Department of Chemical Engineering at Drexel University and the Department of Chemical and Petroleum Engineering at Kansas University. He took part in the ACS

Petroleum Research Fund advisory board meeting in Savannah in February and he participated in the advisory board meeting of the Department of Chemical Engineering at Worcester Polytechnic Institute in April.
